



DEVELOPMENT DIRECTOR GUIDELINES

The NoCo Mini Maker Faire celebrates creativity and innovation by bringing together the community of "doers" and "makers." The Leadership, Entrepreneurship, Arts Advocacy and the Public Program at Colorado State University joined up with the maker faire to put on a Nerdy Derby. The Nerdy Derby is like a pinewood derby, but with a lot less rules, and a lot more creativity. This event allowed arts advocacy students to engage with their community and show the importance of marrying engineering and creativity together. For this event students in an upper division community outreach course were divided into Materials (Development), Construction, Social Media, Visual Communication and Evaluation. These team leaders then led groups of students from two lower division courses to accomplish needed tasks for the event.

The following document is meant to support future team leaders of the Material Development team at future Nerdy Derby/NoCo Mini Maker Faire events. The team gathered materials for wheels, axels, car bodies and decoration for over 300 participants. Team members reached out, mainly by face to face interactions to over 50 businesses in a short three week time span. They then secured donations from 15 local organizations and Colorado State University departments.

Future teams should focus on securing more car kits instead of random wheel and axel parts. This will ensure cars race on the track properly and allow for for better flow and material distribution in the construction process. Additionally, the projected raise in attendee numbers suggest even more donations will be needed in future years.

- Car decorations (here is where the fun, creativity and artistry really comes in): craft supplies, scrap metal, old paint, markers, pens, scissors, brushes, ect.

Our event takes place on Oct. 4th and 5th and we will need all materials by Sept 29th. As a thank you for your time and donation we can feature your organization on our social media and show your logo on the sponsor wall at the event.
